Nagambie Lakes - Victoria

The Nagambie Lakes region is known for its picturesque habitats of tall, shady red river gums and tranquil views of the Goulburn River and surrounding wetlands.

Located just 90 minutes from Melbourne, Nagambie Lakes is a truly relaxing destination where visitors can enjoy premium wines, pristine habitat and quaint towns filled with cafes, local produce stores, antique shops and galleries.

The terroir is well suited to viticulture and the region experiences a cooler and more moderate climate than might first be expected, due to the influence of the many lakes and lagoons to be found throughout. It is the only Australian wine region, and one of only six worldwide, where the meso-climate is dramatically influenced by inland water mass.

WINERY

Tahbilk

Established in 1860, Tahbilk is not only Victoria's and one of Australia's oldest wineries but also boasts the world's largest, and some of the oldest, plantings of Marsanne as well as some of the world's oldest Shiraz vines.

Marsanne, Viognier, Roussanne, Verhelho, Chardonnay, Riesling, Viognier, Shiraz, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Grenache, Mourvedre, Cabernet Franc

The Estate is owned by the Purbrick family who has had 5 generations involved with the company's operations since their purchase of the property in 1925.

Set amongst beautiful gardens, original buildings and underground cellars dating back to the 1860s with a cellar door overlooking the Goulburn River and Café overlooking the fully restored Wetlands area, Tahbilk is an aesthetic paradise.


*Lunch, Wine & Wetland Views \$175 per person**
